Govt. Degree College Uttersoo organized AIDS Awareness Programme

Under the chairmanship of Worthy Principal, Professor Mushtaq Ahmad Sohil, Red Ribbon Committee in collaboration with Department of Zoology and Debates and Seminar Committee organized Awareness Programme on AIDS under the theme "Take the Right Path: My right" today as on 4th December, 2024. The Programme was moderated by Dr. Showkat Hussain Ganie, Co-Convener, Debates and Seminars Committee. The worthy Principal accorded a cordial welcome to the invited speaker, Dr. Muneera Gull from Sub District Hospital, Shangus. Professor Nazir Ahmad Wani, Convener, Red Ribbons delivered the keynote address. In his deliberations, he explained how the HIV makes entry into the host cell and highjacks the metabolism of CD4 cells. He highlighted stages of HIV infection including acute HIV, chronic HIV infection and Acquired Immunodeficiency Syndrome.

After the completion of keynote address, the moderator first highlighted the academic achievements of speaker, Dr. Muneera Gull and then handed over the dice to her for delivering the presentation on the mentioned theme.

She initiated her talk with differentiation of HIV and AIDS. This was followed by explaining the detailed morphology of the HIV. She said that HIV is a retrovirus in which RNA molecule forms DNA by using an enzyme reverse transcriptase.

After discussing the virus morphology, she explained mode of transmission of HIV. Transfusion of contaminated blood, sharing of infected razors, contaminated syringes and needles that are used by intravenous drug abusers and semen and vaginal fluids are the modes of transmission of HIV, the speaker added.

She elaborated symptoms of full blown AIDS including unexplained diarrhoea, fever, weight loss, opportunistic infections like Pneumonia, tuberculosis etc.

The diagnosis of HIV via ELISA, Western blotting and RT-PCR was also explained by speaker.

The speaker delineated different treatments against HIV by using protein and reverse transcriptase inhibitors. She culminated her talk by advising the audience to aware the society about the spread and prevention of AIDS.

The queries related to this disease raised by the audience were all answered by the speaker. Dr. Tariq Bashir, Convener, Debates and Seminars presented vote of thanks in which he thanked worthy principal for his consistent encouragement and support for organizing such types of awareness programmes. He also thanked resource person for her thought provoking talk and the Protocol committee for arranging light refreshments.

The awareness Programme was followed by painting competition in which 15 students of B.G. 5th and 1th semesters participated. The students were asked to display the meaning of the theme "Take the Right Path: My right" in their paintings. The paintings were evaluated by Dr. Sabzar Ahmad Dar, Head, Department of Zoology.
