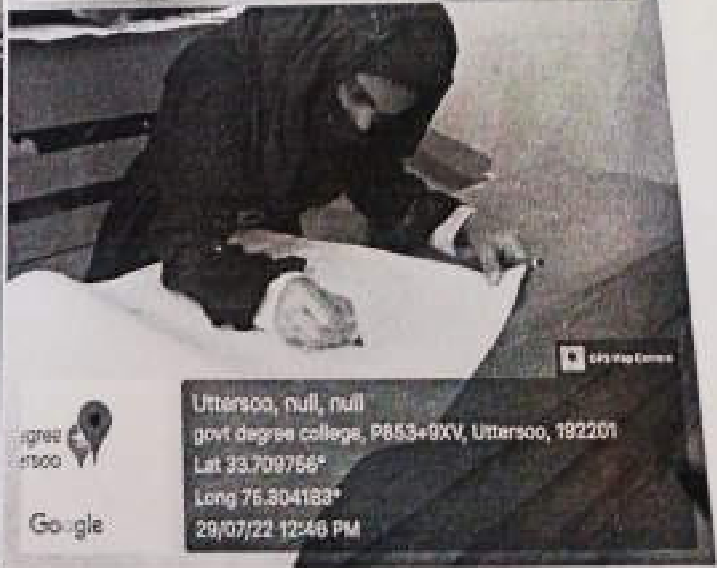
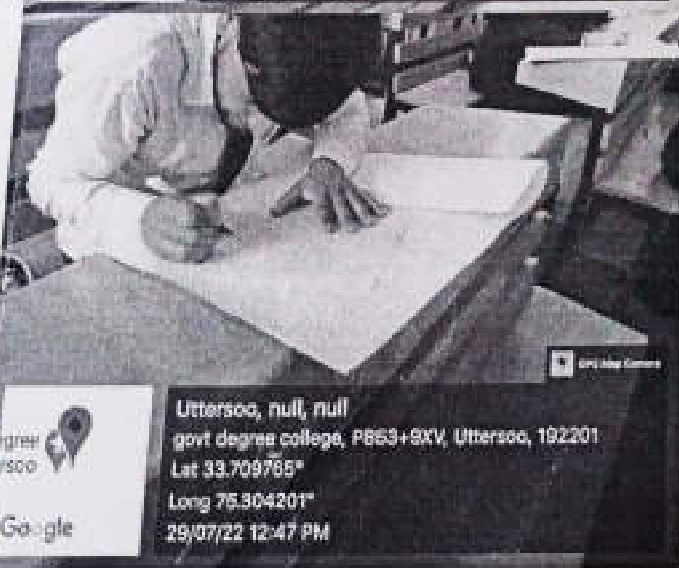
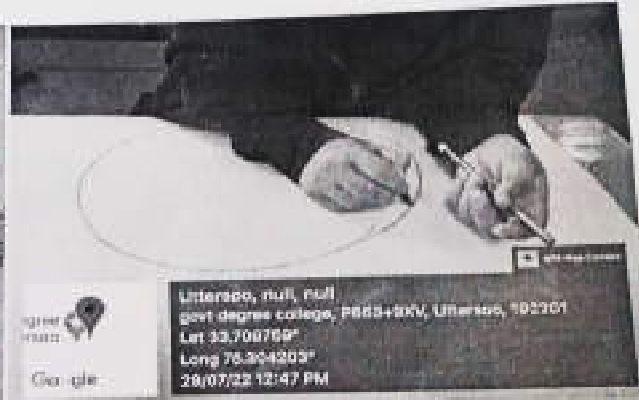
Report of Digital logo drawing on the theme "Digital J&K"


Report on one day seminar on "Gandhi as an architect of Indian freedom struggle"

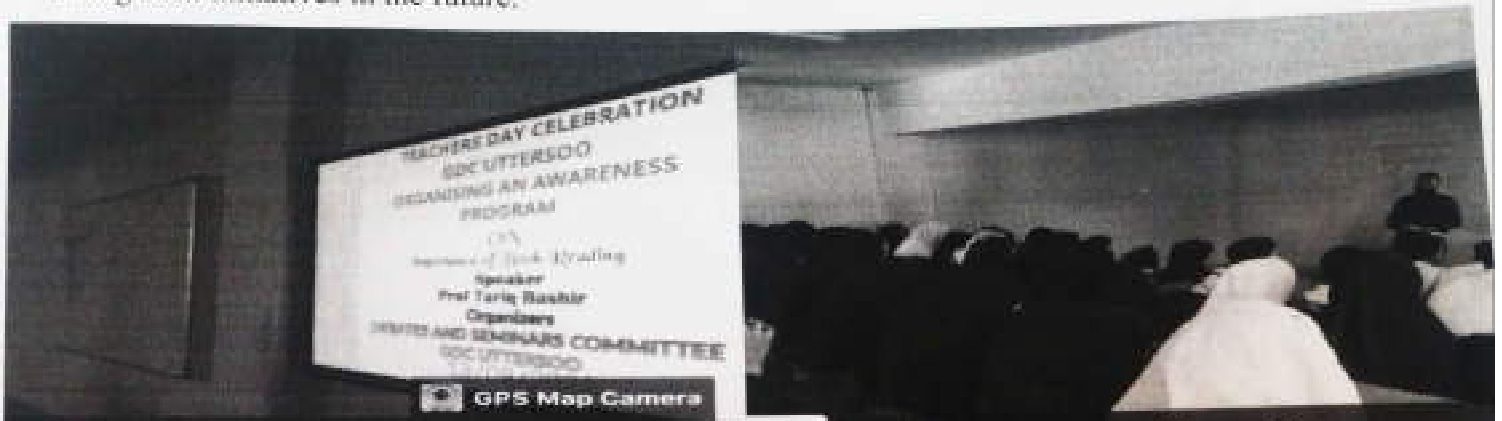
Report on "Book Reading event" as a part of weeklong celebration of Teachers day

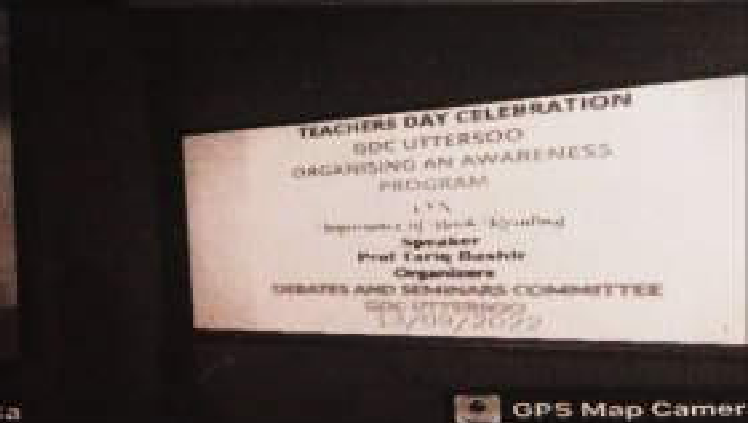

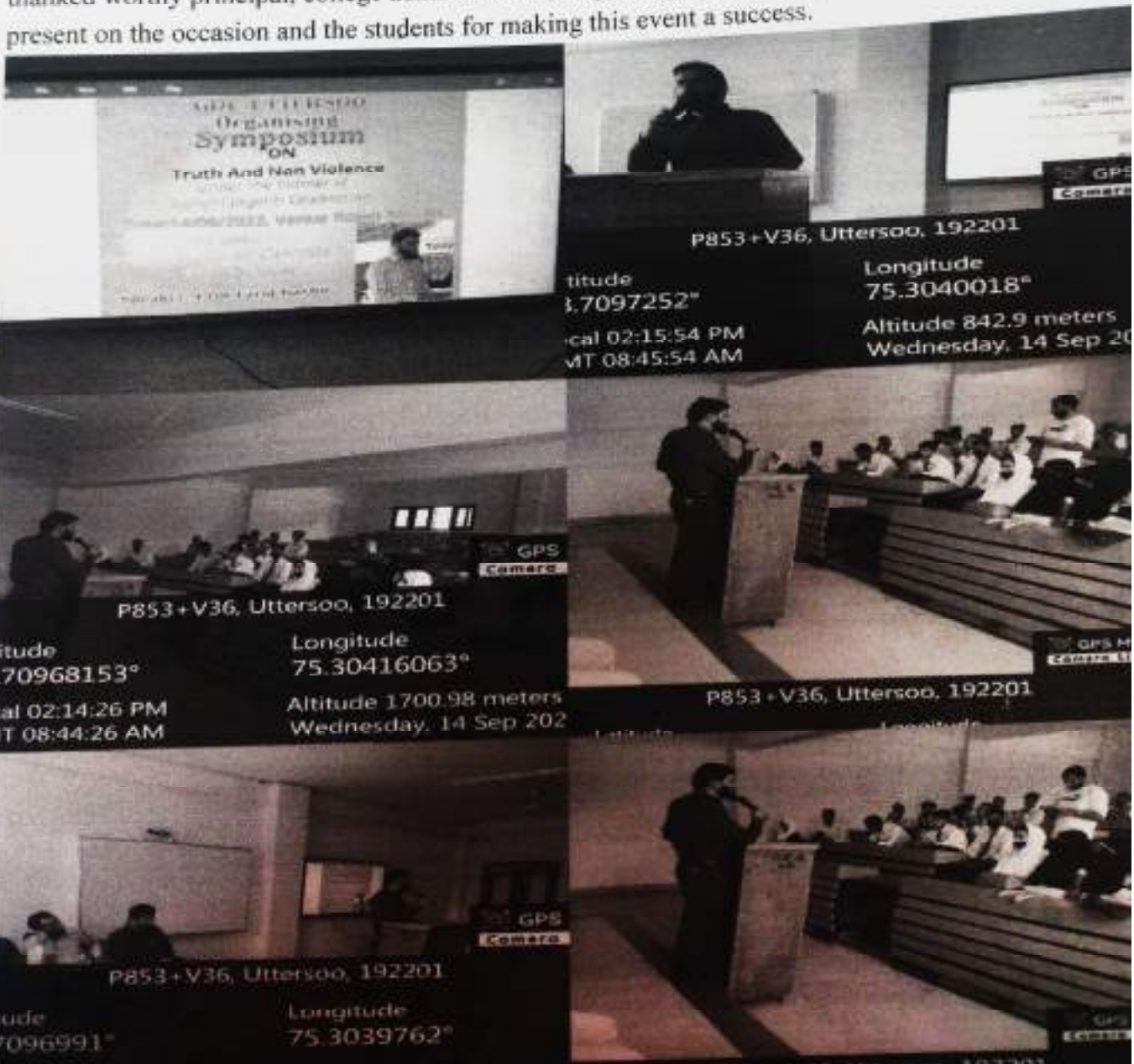

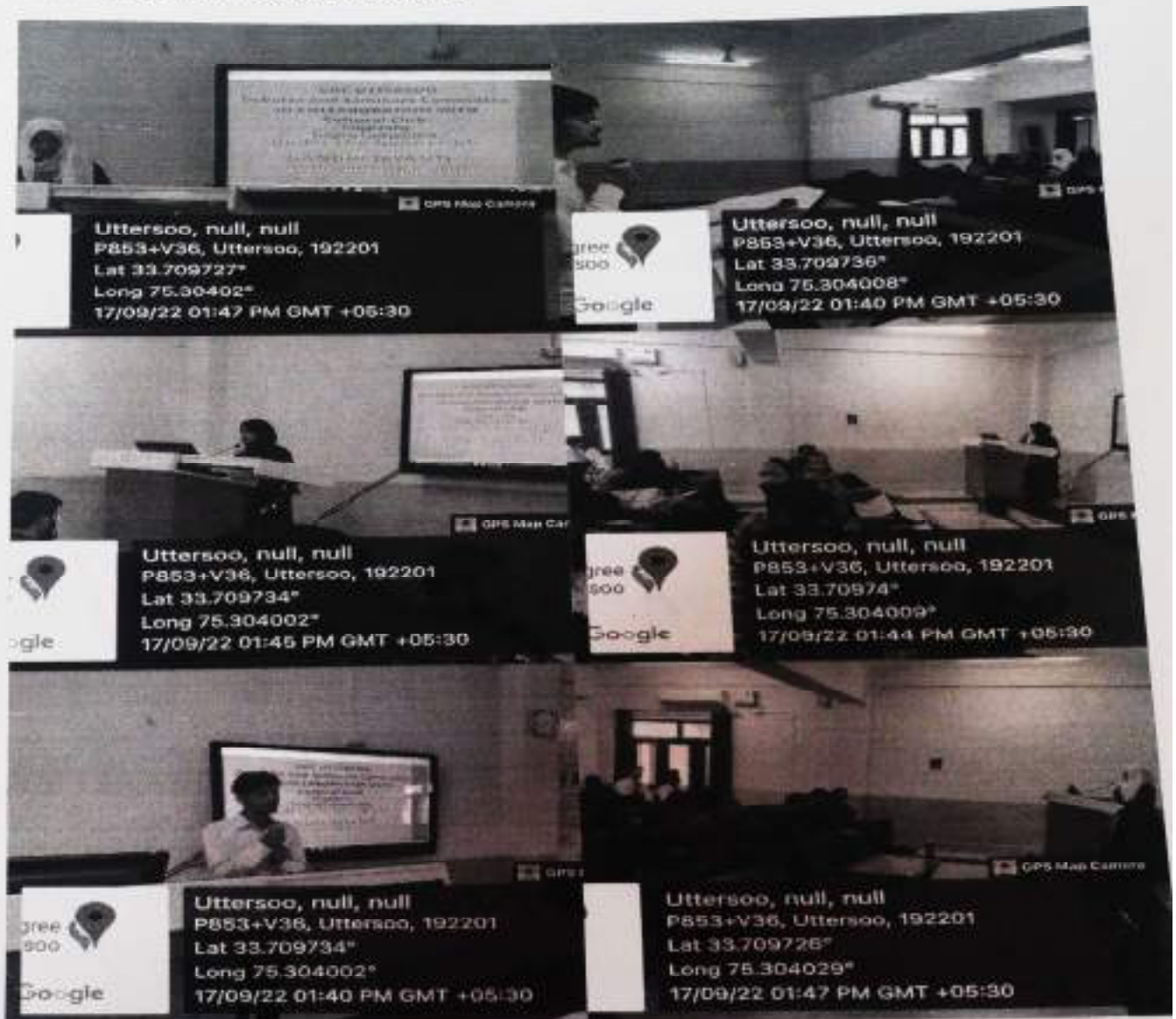
