VENUE: GDC UTTERSOO (inside and outside Campus)

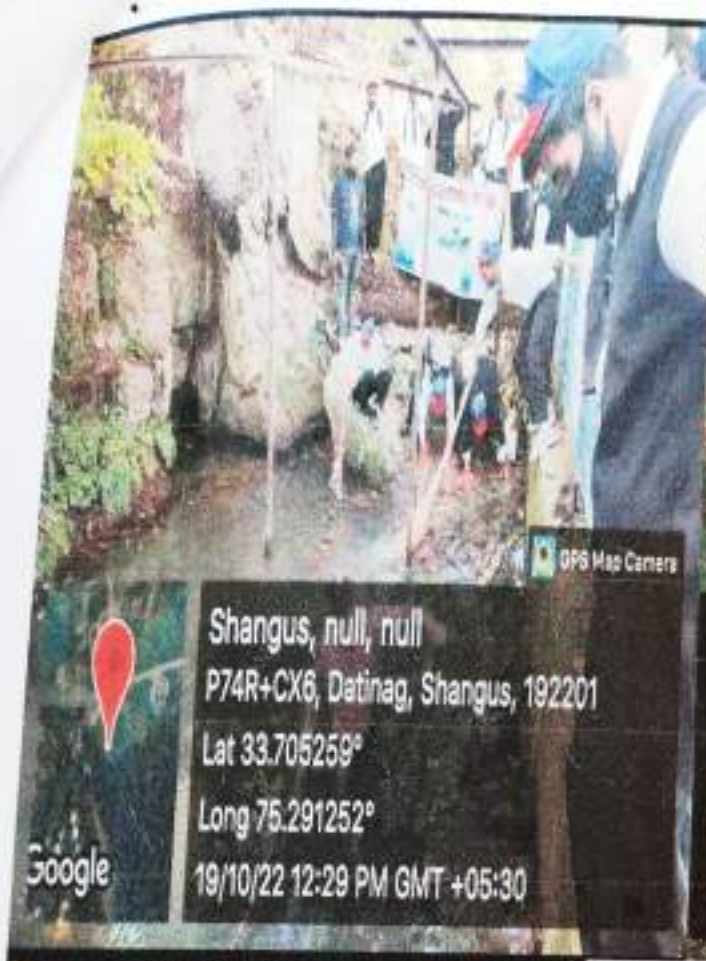
DATINAAG SHANGUS (Water Body)

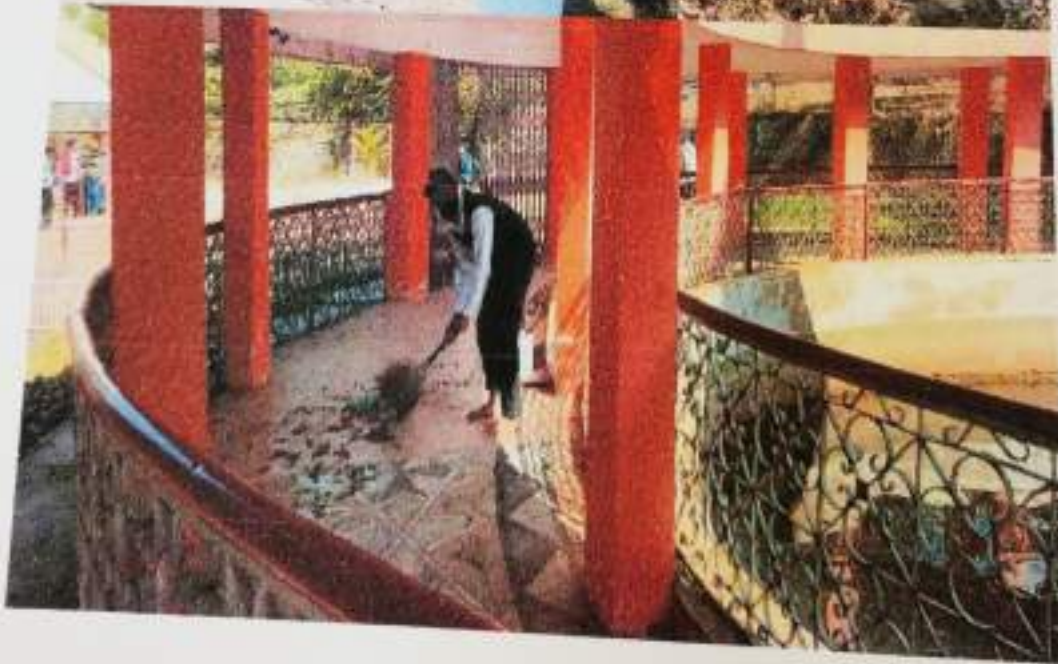

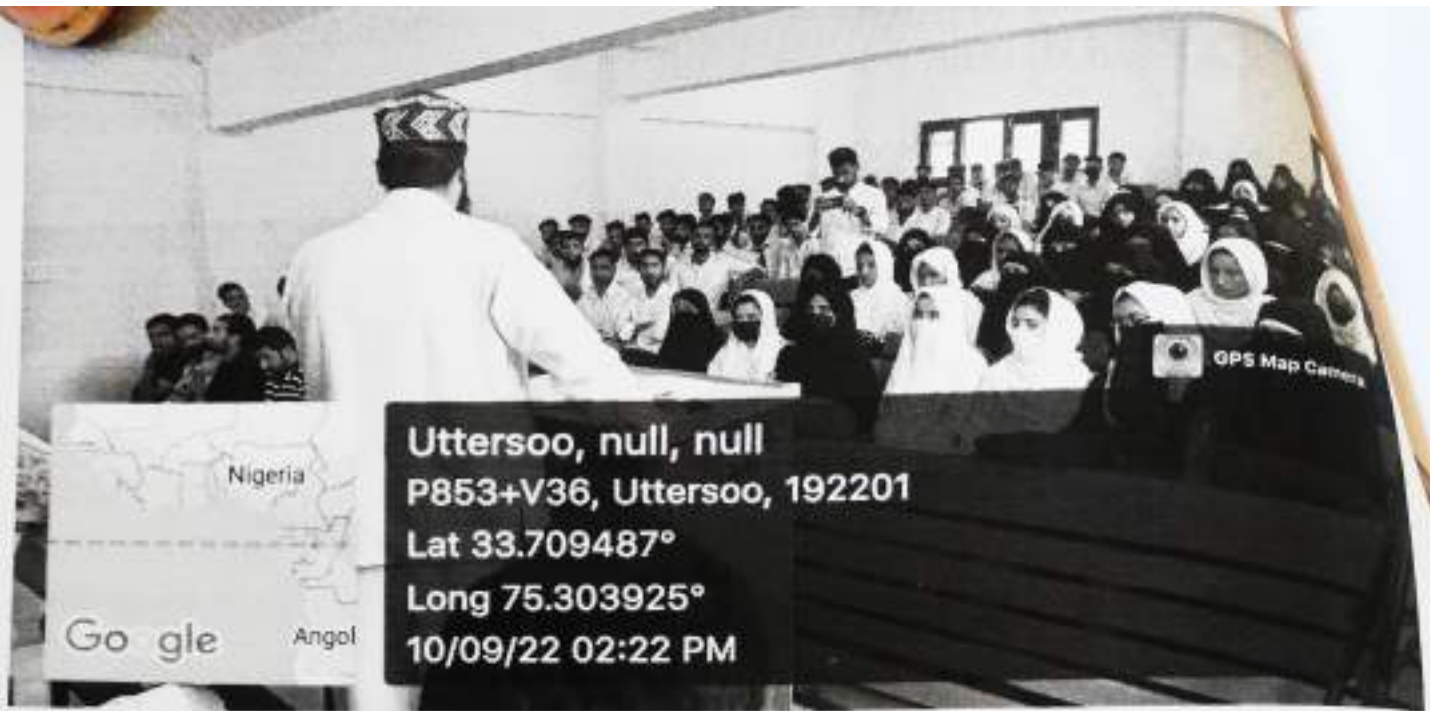
## Report of one day seminar on “Drug De-addiction in the light of Quran and Hadith”

NSS units of the college in collaboration with the debates seminar committee organised a one day seminar on the theme “**Drug De-Addiction In The Light of Quran and Hadith**” under the banner of **Nasha Mukht Bharat Abhiyan**. The seminar was attended by all the staff members of the college and more than 80 students of the college participated in the event. At the very outset Prof. Bilal Ahmad Shah (NSS Programme Officer) introduced the audience to the guest speaker Maulana Irshad Haideri. Maulana irshad talked in detail about the menace of drug addiction where-in he talked about the cause of Drug addiction particularly in the teen age. The guest speaker quoted the report in the greater Kashmir revealing that the number of drug addicted people has increased from 70,000 in 2015 to more than 600,000 in 2021. The guest speaker expressed his deep concern regarding the easy availability of drugs in the market and impressed upon the law enforcing agencies to play their role to control the menace of drug addiction.

The programme ended with the vote of thanks from Prof. Tariq Basher (Convener Debates Seminar) who thanked the worthy principal madam for her support and encouragement, Guest speaker, staff members of the college and the students for making the programme a success.



### Report of One-Day Community Engagement Program at Poshnari – an adopted village

Date: 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022

Village adopted: Poshnari (District – Anantnag)

Targets: Village Poshnari and Govt Middle School Poshnari (Zone – Shangus)

#### Emphasis on:

- *Community engagement: Awareness on sanitation and hygiene*
- *POSHAN Abhiyan – Awareness on the importance of balanced nutrition for lactating mothers and children*

#### Initial report:

A total of around 50 volunteers participated in the program. We left the college at 11 am and reached the target village at 12 PM. Early in the morning, the volunteers prepared food-packets to be distributed to the children in the adopted village.

On reaching the spot, the volunteers led by NSS Program Officers, Mrs Shawana Manzoor and Mr Mohmad Aarif Khanday, interacted with the community members to get inputs on varied socio-economic issues faced by the community.

Later on, the volunteers interacted with the students of the school. Students briefed our volunteers about the issues they face in the school.

The lactating mothers of the area were provided POSHAN food kits that included among other food items – Brown bread, boiled eggs, butter packets, biscuits, bananas, etc.

#### Important observations:

The NSS Program officers/ volunteers, after interacting with the community, made the following observations:

##### A. Village level:

1. The village is situated some 5 kms away from the Block office, Chittergul.

2. Facilities of drinking water and electricity are available.
3. The area has dense plantation cover.
4. The village has been declared as Open Defecation Free (ODF).
5. The knowledge about Government schemes/ flagship programmes is lagging.
6. Literacy rate is roughly down.
7. The people aren't as health conscious as they ought to be in this era.
8. Awareness about the sanitation is lagging.
9. Due to poverty, the children are malnourished.
10. The major population depends on agriculture for its livelihood.

**B. School level:**

1. The school is housed in a single building with insufficient classroom space and dearth of student support facilities.
2. The school building isn't fenced.
3. Equipment for digital literacy like Desktops, laptops and smart boards are missing.
4. Playground for the students isn't available.

**Recommendations:**

**Community development:-** For the socio-economic development of the village, following recommendations are to be put under the notice of the District Administration for perusal and action.

1. Mass awareness programs on health, hygiene and sanitation need to be organized
2. The children need to be covered under POSHAN Abhiyan and similar flagship programs of the government
3. More awareness needs to be spread vis-à-vis Government's flagship programs for the welfare of the community
4. Awareness camps regarding the importance of education and literacy need to be organized and the community needs to be engaged in whatsoever ways

**School:-** The school authorities have toiled a lot to bring the school close to the best schools in the zone despite the fact that the population there is primarily tribal. The students, though belonging to the poor families, are well trained. However, following recommendations are to be put under the notice of the concerned authorities to improve the overall condition of the school:

1. Only five staff members are present to look after a school with 8 levels/ classes. More staff should be deployed
2. The students should be given chance to express their skills and talent at a bigger platform
3. A few desktops/ laptop computers should be sanctioned to be used by the school children

4. The school building should be fenced as there is possibility of man-animal conflict as the area is in close connection with the forest
5. A playground needs to be developed for the students and some land needs to be acquired for the same.
