
GDC Uttersoo celebrated 75th Republic Day

Under the banner of Nasha Mukt Abhiyan and G-20 and patronage of Worthy Principal, Professor Syed Javaid Hussain, Debates and Seminar Committee, NSS Unit in collaboration with District Police, Anantnag organized one day Seminar on Drug De-addiction today on 18th November, 2023. The programme was moderated by Dr. Showkat Hussain Ganie, Co-Convener Debates and Seminar Committee. The Worthy Principal, Professor Syed javaid Hussain delivered the welcome address in which he welcomed all the participants particularly to Mr. Raqeeb Ahmad (Sub Divisional Police Officer, Achabal), Mr. Mohd Ashraf (Station House Officer, Uttersoo), Learned speaker from the Drug De-addiction Centre, Ms. Mudasir Aziz and Dr. Muneera Gull from Sub District Hospital Shangus. The worthy Principal also stressed that Government has a primary responsibility to counteract the drug trafficking and drug abuse although communities can also make a major contribution. Educational institutions, Religious organizations and elder members of a family can play vital role to eradicate the drug menace from its roots, the worthy Principal added.






Professor Nazir Ahmad Wani, Assistant Professor and Head, Department of Chemistry and Physics delivered keynote address in which he elaborated the science of addiction. He highlighted that use of substances including marijuana, opioids, cocaine etc. trigger the brain to release excess dopamine. Dopamine signal alter neural connectivity that could lead to repeat the activity time and again without thinking much about it and thus the result is habit and addiction, he added.

The first learned speaker on the occasion was Mr. Raqeeb Ahmad. Sub Divisional Police Officer, Achabal. The illustrious speaker talked about the role played by the police department for uprooting

the menace of Drug Abuse. While hinting to certain Govt. Acts, he said that police always remains on tenterhooks to nab the main culprits, that is, the drug peddlers. However, he emphasized that nothing substantial and durable can be achieved without the coordination of the general public. He also advised the educational institutions must frame the committee that shall keep an eagle eye on the suspected students. His speech was followed by student talks. The list of students who deliberated upon the drug abuse includes Mr. Suhalb Ahmad, Ms. Rahiqa Lateef, Ms. Iqra Majeed, Ms. Sabiya Yousuf and Mr. Murtaza Ahmad Chowan. Mr. Suhalb Ahmad played momentous video with a message that drug addictions could lead to deterioration of health and social life. Other students highlighted that drug addiction ruins the path of progress of individuals in every respect and therefore, the proactive measures in the form of awareness programmes must be taken in order to stop the youth from this menace.









The Programme was moderated by Professor Basharat Hussain Bhat, Assistant Professor and Head, Department of Economics. The worthy Principal, Professor Syed Javaid Hussain delivered the welcome address in which he cordially welcomed the senior most faculty, Professor Nazir Ahmad Wani, Mr. Rayees Ahmad (Agriculture Extension Officer Shangus, Dr. Iqra (Vetinary Assistant Surgeon, Shangus), other esteemed guests from Agriculture Department, Faculty members and students.

Mr. Rayees Ahmad, Agriculture extension Officer acquainted the audience particularly the students about immense potential of agri-entrepreneurship and the opportunities provided by Govt, of India through flagship Holistic Agriculture Development Plan (HADP). Speaking of the event, Mr. Rayees Ahmad advised the students to avail the benefits of various government schemes in the agriculture sector including irrigation schemes, Krishi Udan scheme, PM Fasal Bima Yojana and others. The worthy speaker also assured the worthy Principal that Agriculture Department shall provide full training on the cultivation of Mushrooms to students of Govt. Degree College Uttersoo and shall make them aware how to identify and sustainably manage pest and diseases and weed mushrooms.

The kind lady elaborated that production of wool has gone down because of scattered production, scantiness of processing facilities and diminishing of cottage industries. The illustrious speaker added that there are a number of HADP projects aimed to uplift the sheep farming mainly in the Kashmir division and thereby enhancing the production and processing of wool.





The speech was followed by thorough 30 minute question-answer session in which learned speakers answered all the queries raised by worthy Principal and the audience. 
GDC Uttersoo organized Awareness Programme on Red Cross Day

The worthy Principal cordially welcomed the gatherings particularly learned speaker of the day, Mr. Mohd Afzal, Community Health Officer, Shangus. The esteemed Principal also elaborated the message of Red Cross day that one must be always ready to help the humanity especially during the unfavourable environments. The Key note address was delivered by Dr. Sabzar Ahmad Dar, Assistant Professor and Head, Department of Zoology. The worthy speaker elaborated that review of literature confirms 90.04% of the orchard farmers of Kashmir valley suffer from acute ailments including brain tumours due to the continuous exposure to pesticides. Keeping these problems in view he and his research team determined the endosulfan (Insectiside) induced genotoxicity and mutagenesis in aquatic life. This excellent research caused the ban of using endosulphan by the Govt. of India, the speaker said. The Keynote speech was followed by elaborative talk by Community Health Officer, Mr. Mohd Afzal. The speaker initiated his talk with history behind the creation of Red Cross Society and celebration of Red Cross Day. He lucidly explained the role of Red Cross in healthcare including hospital services, blood bank, HIV/AIDS programmes, establishment of vocational training centers, conduct of workshops to prevent the spread of communicable and infectious diseases etc.





Under the Chairmanship of Worthy Principal, Professor Syed Javaid Hussain, Department of Chemistry in collaboration with Debates and Seminar Committee celebrated World No Tobacco Day under the theme "Protecting Children from Tobacco Industry Interference" today on 3rd June, 2024. The Programme was moderated by Dr. Showkat Hussain Ganle, Co-Convener, Debates and Seminar Committee. The Worthy Principal, Prof. (Dr.) Syed Javaid Hussain welcomed the gathering, especially the leader Speaker, Dr. Raiees Ahmad from Sub District Hospital, Shangus, Anantnag. The esteemed Principal also delivered the keynote address in which he stressed that the smoking menace must be eradicated from the grassroots level. He added that laws against tobacco smoking should be framed by Government of India so that this addiction can be decimated from the society. Awareness Programmes regarding the ill effects of smoking at Educational Institutions in the form of Seminars are also required to curb this menace. The Keynote speech was followed by extensive talk by the learned speaker of the Day, Dr. Raiees Ahmad from Sub District Hospital, Shangus. The need of the hour is to make aware our family, friends the whole society regarding detrimental effects of smoking that shall result significant decrease in use of tobacco and ultimately will ensure decline in harmful diseases including cancer and heart ailments, the speaker said. The talk was followed by brief speech by Professor N. A. Wani, Associate Professor and Head, Department of Chemistry in which he advised the audience that choose Life not Tobacco. There was 15 minute question answer session in which the speaker replied to every query raised by the gathering. GDC Uttersoo organized extension Lecture on different approaches to the study of Indian Nationalism: A Critical Analysis



He highlighted colonial approach in which he mentioned that British did not consider the India as a Nation. In the Nationalist approach, he elucidated that Indian Stalwarts rejected colonial approach and declared India as a Nation in Making. The Nationalist approach is of the view that with the spread of Modern Education, India will become a full fledged Nation. Marxist approach negated the approach of both colonists and nationalists and highlighted that class differentiation, modes and means of production are important for the emergence of Nation, the speaker added. Lastly the speaker highlighted the Subaltern approach which completely undermined the thought of Nationalist, Colonist and Marxist approaches as all the three highlighted the contribution of elitist class only and undermined the contributions of common masses.
