
Report of Cleanliness Drive in College Campus on 23/03/2024







Report of Cleanliness Drive and Waste Segregation Demonstration in College Campus on 05/06/2024





Today on the 5th of June 2024 the Department of Environmental Science in collaboration with the NSS unit, Eco-Club, and Debates/seminar Committee of GDC Uttersoo started a week-long program on the eve of the World Environment Week 2024 under the theme, "Our land. Our future. We are # Generation Restoration". The program started with Cleanliness Drive and Waste Segregation Demonstration in the college Campus. The cleanliness drive was kickstarted with the address by worthy Principal Prof Syed Javaid Hussain, who not only highlighted the importance of Cleanliness but the role that academicians, policy makers, and students have to play with respect to the conservation of the environment. Prof Rouoof Habib, NSS Program Officer, and HOD Environmental Science demonstrated the segregation of waste by highlighting the use of color-coded dustbins for

separating the wet and bio-degradable wastes from the non-biodegradable which could otherwise min recyclables by being in the wrong place. 




Report of Cleanliness cum Environmental Awareness Drive at Chatabal Anantnag



Under the Chairmanship of Worthy Principal. Prof (Dr.) Syed Javaid Hussain, Department of Environmental Science in collaboration with NSS and Debates and Seminar Committee concluded the events of Environment week with student presentations today on 11th June, 2024. The celebration of Environment week under the theme "Our Land Our Future, We are ≠ Generation Restoration" was started on 5th June, 2024 with cleanliness drive inside the college Campus. It was followed by a Painting Competition on 6th June, 2024 in which scores of students participated. The multiple paintings put forth by the participating students proved that our generations are highly skilled to highlight the environmental concerns through their artefacts.

The next programme of the series of events was a Nature Trip to Chatabal on 8th June, 2024 in which **Prof. Rouf Habib**, Head Department of Environmental Science gave the onsite demonstrations to the students on how the forests function as carbon sinks and how the biodiversity increases the stability to an ecosystem. Quiz Competition was organized on 10th June, 2024 in which the participating students exhibited their attachment with the environment thereby becoming a medium to encourage others for behaving as reasonable members of the society vis-a-vis the environment which we all are a part of.

The week-long programme came to its close with a student debate competition on "Our Land Our The week-long programme came to its close with a student debate competition on "Our Land Our Future, We are # Generation Restoration". The Programme was moderated by **Dr. Showkat Hussain** Ganie, Head, Department of Botany. The Programme started with inaugural speech by **Worthy Principal** in which he elucidated that organizing awareness programmes which are environment related leads to sustainable use of natural resources that will keep the ecosystems in equilibrium. The worthy chair also highlighted the support of Govt, of Jammu and Kashmir to IUCN and WWF to protect the Hangul and its habitat.

The inaugural address was followed by debate competition in which registered students were allowed to present their talks on the theme "Our Land Our Future, We are ≠ Generation Restoration". Four students namely Auneeb Abbas (B.G. 2" semester student), Shahnaza Majeed (B.G. 4" semester student), Syed Zeeshan Manzoor (B.G. 4" semester student) and Faizan Yousuf (B.G. 4" semester student) participated in the debate competition.

Syed Zeeshan Manzoor stressed that biodiversity is under threat due to the habitat destruction and pollution and therefore, conservation of biodiversity is the need of hour. Auneeb abbas in his talk mentioned awareness programmes and collaboration between the Educational Institutions and Govt of India are required to check the biodiversity loss. Miss. Shahnaza Majeed advised the gatherings that let's be greeny and not the greedy. The last student speaker was Faizan Yousuf. This budding student urged the gatherings to put polythene bags and other wastes in dustbins. He continued that we must not put animal and other wastes in open places as such practices harm our environment. The student talks were evaluated by Jury members who include Prof. Nazir Ahmad Wani, Head, Department of Chemistry, Dr. Mohd Ashraf, Head Department of Urdu and Dr. Tariq Bashir, Head, department of History. Shahnaza Majeed obtained the 4th position; whereas, 3rd and 2rd positions were secured by Auneeb Abbas and Syed Zeeshan, respectively. The winner of the debate competition was Faizan Yousuf. All the student participants were highly appreciated by the worthy

Principal. 
Report of International Yoga Day on 21st June 2024


