Govt. Degree College organized an Extensive cleanliness Drive of an adopted water body "Shakar-Naag".



Under the chairmanship of Worthy Principal, Professor Mushtaq Ahmad Sohil, the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan cell organized an extensive cleanliness drive of an adopted water body Shakar-naag, Uttersoo today as on 13th November, 2025. The team, comprising students, teaching, and nonteaching staff, under the supervision of Coordinator Dr. Aabid Yousuf, left the college premises at around 12:30 p.m. for the said purpose, equipped with brooms, long wooden sticks, gloves, and other cleaning materials. The group reached the site at 12:45 p.m. Before commencing the drive, Dr. Aabid Yousuf addressed the participants and highlighted the significance of the Shakar-Naag water body as the primary source of drinking water for the village of Uttersoo. He emphasized that maintaining the cleanliness of this water body is a collective responsibility to prevent the spread of water-borne diseases.


This was followed by an informative talk on various sources of water body contamination by Dr. Showkat Hussain Ganie, Head, Department of Botany. He explained that the excessive algal proliferation on the water surface results in oxygen depletion, thereby threatening the survival of aquatic fauna. Dr. Showkat Hussain Ganie further added that the water body remains open, fallen chinar leaves often accumulate on its surface, leading to contamination. Following the briefing, the team began the extensive cleanliness drive. The surrounding area of the water body was first


cleaned using brooms, and the collected waste was properly disposed of at designated dumping sites. Subsequently, the main water body was cleaned. Surface contaminants, including dead leaves and algae growth, were removed with the help of long wooden sticks by the teaching staff, nonteaching staff, and students. The waste collected from the water body was also dumped at the

Posters carrying awareness messages such as "Save Water, Save Life," "Let's Prevent Diseases by Keeping Water Bodies Clean," and "Stop Wasting Water" were displayed on the fencing walls of the water body to spread awareness among the local community.

The drive concluded successfully at 2:20 p.m. After completion, all participants were served light refreshments and tea. The Worthy Principal appreciated and congratulated all members of the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan team for organizing this commendable and socially significant activity.


