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GDC Uttersoo organized extension lecture on Awareness regarding Rights of Persons with Disabilities

Under The patronage of Worthy Principal, Professor Mushtaq Ahmad Sohil, Debates and Seminar Committee in collaboration with Department of Sociology organized extension lecture on Awareness regarding Rights of Persons with Disabilities today as on 7th December, 2024. Dr. Showkat Hussain Ganie, Co-Convener, Debates and Seminar Committee moderated the event. The Worthy Principal accorded a warm welcome to the gathering. He also highlighted that persons with disabilities can achieve remarkable heights if provided with suitable opportunities. The welcome address was followed by keynote address delivered by Dr. Mudasar Ahmed from the Department of Sociology in which he provided the accurate statistics about disabled population across the world. He said that in India 2.6% of India's total population lives with disabilities. As per the recent reports (2011), 361, 00 individuals of the union territory Jammu and Kashmir are disabled, the keynote speaker added.

The keynote was followed by a comprehensive talk by Dr. Tariq Bashir, Convener, Debates and Seminar Committee and Head, Department of History. He initiated his talk by sharing insights from his perspective as a person with visual impairment. The speaker highlighted the various challenges he faced throughout his life and reflected on how a radio talk show motivated him to resume his education after a gap of eight years. He urged the audience to accept their responsibilities in providing assistance and support to individuals with disabilities. He stated that it is essential for everyone to fulfil their duty towards the disabled community. The first step is the identification of children with disabilities in a community followed by assisting them to obtain disability certificates from the district hospital. Their families must be made aware about government initiatives, particularly the Integrated Social Security Schemes for their disabled children. He also stressed that encouragement to parents of disabled children is required so that they could enrol them in educational institutions, as education serves as a fundamental tool for their empowerment. The importance of both government and non-government organizations in contributing to the welfare of individuals with disabilities was also discussed by the speaker. He concluded his talk by reminding the gathering about responsibility of healthy individuals in assisting the rehabilitations of the adult disabled population.


The worthy Principal, Professor Mushtaq Ahmed Sohil praised the Debates and seminars committee for organizing these types of extension lectures. In addition, he appreciated Dr.

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Mudassar Ahmed and Dr. Tariq Bashir for presenting theme oriented speeches. Dr. Showkat Hussain Ganie, Head of the Department of Botany and Co-convener, Debates and seminars committee was also acknowledged for handling the programme with thoughtfulness and maturity.
