In pursuance of Circular No. 12-JK(GAD) of 2025; dated: 21-05-2025 issued by the General Administration Department, Government of Jammu & Kashmir, and as endorsed by the Higher Education Directorate (Ref: HED/ADM/91/2025-04; dated: 27-05-2025), all concerned heads, coordinators are hereby instructed to undertake a **comprehensive audit of IT infrastructure** across their respective units in the overall supervision of the designated Information Security Officer [ISO] Mr. Ummar Muhammad, Assistant Professor Computer Applications. The audit shall include but is not limited to the following:

- 1. Inventory of Desktop/Laptop Systems
 - ± Count and configuration details of all computing devices.
- 2. Operating System Status
 - Verification of licensing, update status, and support lifecycle (e.g., Windows 11, Linux variants).
- 3. Installed Software Audit
 - ± Listing of genuine vs. pirated applications.
- 4. Cybersecurity Assessment
 - ± Active antivirus/firewall presence, status of latest updates, threat detection records.
- 5. Network and Access Point Mapping
 - Architecture overview, Wi-Fi/router configurations, and security protocols in place.

Compliance Requirements

- ± Only licensed, currently supported operating systems and software shall be used.
- ± All machines must be protected by active antivirus/firewall systems.
- ± No obsolete or pirated software shall be retained.
- ± Administrative privileges should be restricted and monitored to prevent unauthorized access by the ISO.

A standard IT asset inventory format will be circulated by the IT Department to ensure uniform documentation and reporting.

Timeline: All departments are requested to complete the audit exercise and submit the compiled report to the undersigned through the ISO by 16 August 2025.

Non-compliance and non-cooperation with the concerned ISO shall be viewed seriously and may invite disciplinary action as per institutional and departmental protocols.

In pursuance of Circular No. 12-JK(GAD) of 2025; dated: 21.05.2025 issued by the General Administration Department, Government of Jammu & Kashmir-endorsed by the Higher Education Department vide communication No. HED/ADM/91/2025-04(7650751); dated: 27.05.2025—and in continuation of institutional compliance efforts, the following directives are hereby issued for immediate implementation:

- 1. Exclusive Use of Government Email IDs: All staff members shall mandatorily utilize official NIC-provided email IDs for all forms of official correspondence. This circular is issued in the interest of safeguarding institutional data, mitigating phishing risks, and fostering a secure and policy-compliant digital ecosystem, in line with the IT governance protocols prescribed by the Government of Jammu & Kashmir.

Non-conformity may be viewed as a breach of administrative conduct and shall invite appropriate action as per institutional norms.

All concerned are directed to treat this circular with utmost seriousness and ensure full compliance with immediate effect.

Agenda & Discussion Points

Opening Remarks

The meeting commenced with an introduction by the Convener, highlighting the objectives aligned with Cyber Security and IT Governance Guidelines.

Worthy Principal welcomed members and emphasized the broader implications of institutional IT compliance, referencing official communication from the Higher Education Department.

After remarks by the worthy Principal, the session was handed over to Ummar Muhammad, the Convener IT Committee who after thorough discussion highlighted that in pursuit of robust institutional IT practices, digital transparency, and alignment with Government of India directives and ISO standards, the following resolutions are hereby adopted at Government Degree College Uttersoo for immediate implementation:

1. Discontinuation of Private or Unauthorized Government Websites

- The official institutional website of the college is now fully transitioned to the domain gdcuttersoo.ac.in, provisioned by ERNET India, thereby conforming to Ministry of Education norms on secure domain allocation.
- Hosting and content management responsibilities are vested with the Directorate of IT & SS, University of Kashmir, ensuring centralized oversight and regular maintenance.
- An active SSL certificate has been successfully integrated to guarantee encrypted data transmission, user privacy, and secure communication across all digital platforms.

2. Mandatory Usage of Government-Provided Email IDs for Official Communication

- All institutional correspondence must henceforth be routed exclusively through NIC-provided Government Email IDs to safeguard confidentiality, prevent unauthorized access, and facilitate secure archiving of official communications.
- Usage of personal or third-party email accounts (e.g., Gmail, Yahoo, Outlook) for institutional correspondence is strictly prohibited.
- A comprehensive circular shall be issued immediately, directing the complete shift to official NIC email accounts and listing the verified institutional email IDs for:
 - Principal, Teaching Faculty & non-teaching staff
 - Director Colleges
 - Administrative Department
- 3. Comprehensive Audit of Institutional IT Infrastructure in Conformity with ISO Protocols To strengthen cybersecurity and infrastructure integrity, a full-scale audit shall be initiated under the supervision of ISO, encompassing:
 - Verification of all software licensing and compliance status
 - Review of antivirus solutions, update regularity, and threat protection mechanisms
 - Firewall installation, activation, and configuration of access restrictions
 - Exhaustive inventory of all hardware and peripheral assets, along with usability assessment
 - Identification & decommissioning of outdated/legacy/unprotected systems & software
 - Administrative access to all software & hardware resources is restricted and monitored. The audit report shall be compiled and submitted to the relevant authorities for actionable recommendations.

Circular No. 12-JK(GAD) of 2025 Dated: 21.05.2025

Attention of all Administrative Departments, Heads of Departments (HoDs), and Subordinate Offices is invited to the discussions held in the meeting convened under the chairmanship of the Chief Secretary, Jammu & Kashmir, wherein the need for enforcing a secure, standardized, and policy-compliant digital and IT environment across Government establishments was extensively deliberated.

In view of the growing risks associated with unauthorized digital platforms, outdated hardware/software infrastructure, and increasing incidents of data compromise and phishing, the following comprehensive set of instructions is hereby issued for immediate implementation and strict compliance:

1. Discontinuation of Private/Unauthorised Government Websites:

It has come to notice that various departments are operating official websites using private domains such as ".com", ".org", or ".net", which are not aligned with Government of India guidelines on official domain usage.

Accordingly, all such privately hosted/unauthorized departmental websites shall be deactivated forthwith. NIC, J&K Centre shall assist departments in migrating all existing websites to secure and authenticated government domains, preferably under ".gov.in" or ".jk.gov.in". No future departmental websites shall be developed or hosted on non-government domains. All proposals for new websites must be routed through NIC and approved by the IT Department.

2. Mandatory Use of Government Email IDs for Official Communication:

To maintain data confidentiality and prevent leakage of sensitive information, No official communication shall be made or responded to, if transmitted from non-government email accounts such as Gmail, Yahoo, Rediffmail, etc. All officers/officials shall mandatorily use NIC-provided email Ids (...@jk.gov.in / ...@gov.in) for all forms of official correspondence. HoDs shall ensure immediate issuance and activation of official NIC email IDs for all staff involved in administrative or public-facing roles. Any emails received from non-NIC domains shall be treated as unofficial and may not be acted upon.

3 Comprehensive IT Infrastructure Audit by CISOs/ISOs:

All Chief Information Security Officers (CISOs) / Information Security Officers (ISOs) designated in each department shall conduct a detailed census and audit of IT infrastructure, which shall include:

Number and specifications of desktop/laptop systems;

Status of operating systems (licensed / unlicensed, updated / outdated);

III. Inventory of installed software (genuine vs pirated);

IV. Antivirus/firewall status and last update logs;

Network architecture, access points, and security configuration.

It must be ensured that all machines run genuine, licensed, and currently supported operating systems (e.g., Windows 11, Linux variants, etc.);

No pirated, obsolete, or end-of-life software is used;

Devices are protected with active antivirus/firewall systems;

III. Administrative access to systems is restricted and monitored.

A standard IT asset inventory format shall be circulated separately by the IT Department to facilitate uniform reporting.

4. Sensitization and Capacity Building of CISOs and IT Staff:

NIC shall organize mandatory sensitization sessions for departmental CISOs/ISOs, focusing on.

Basic and advanced cyber hygiene practices;
