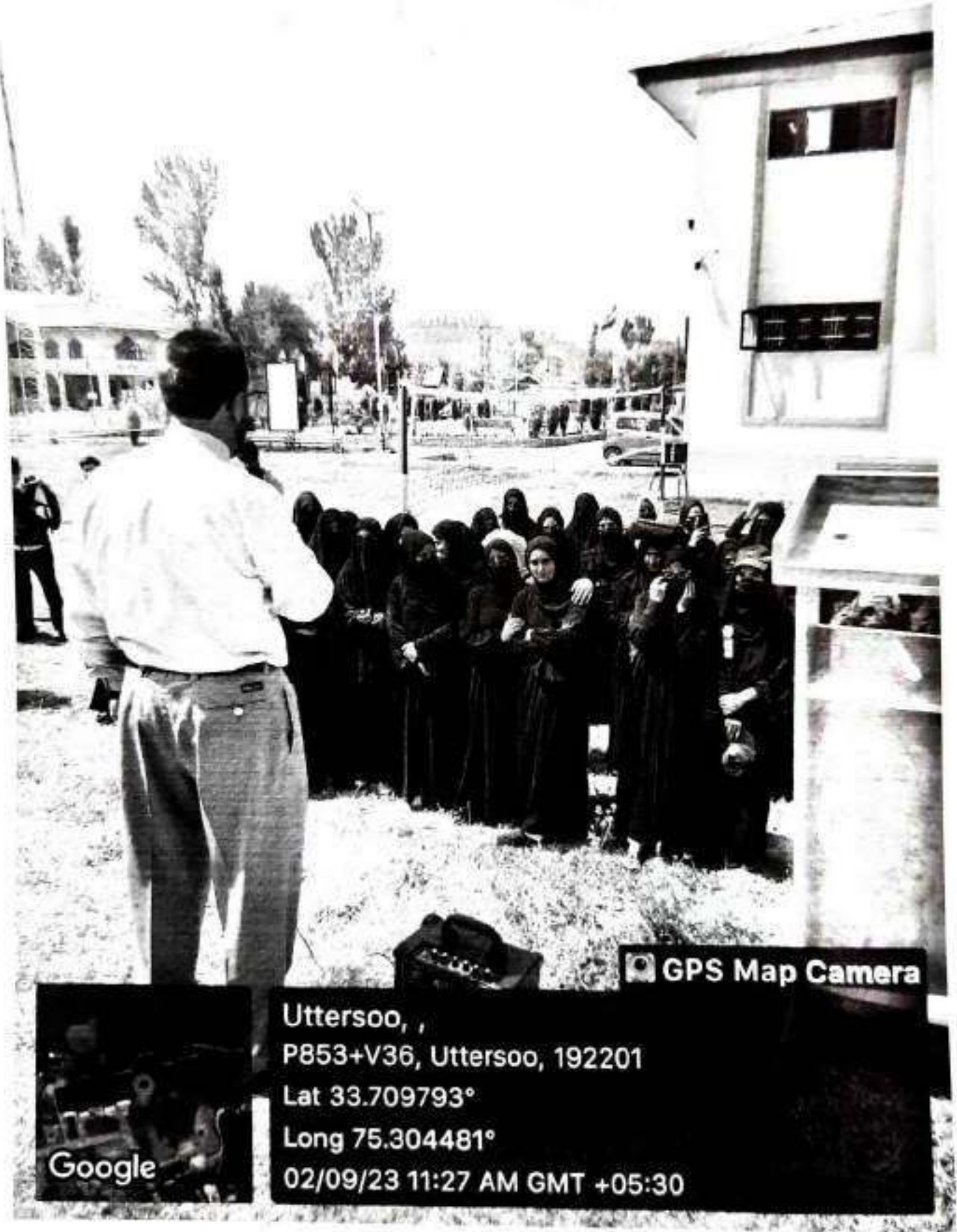

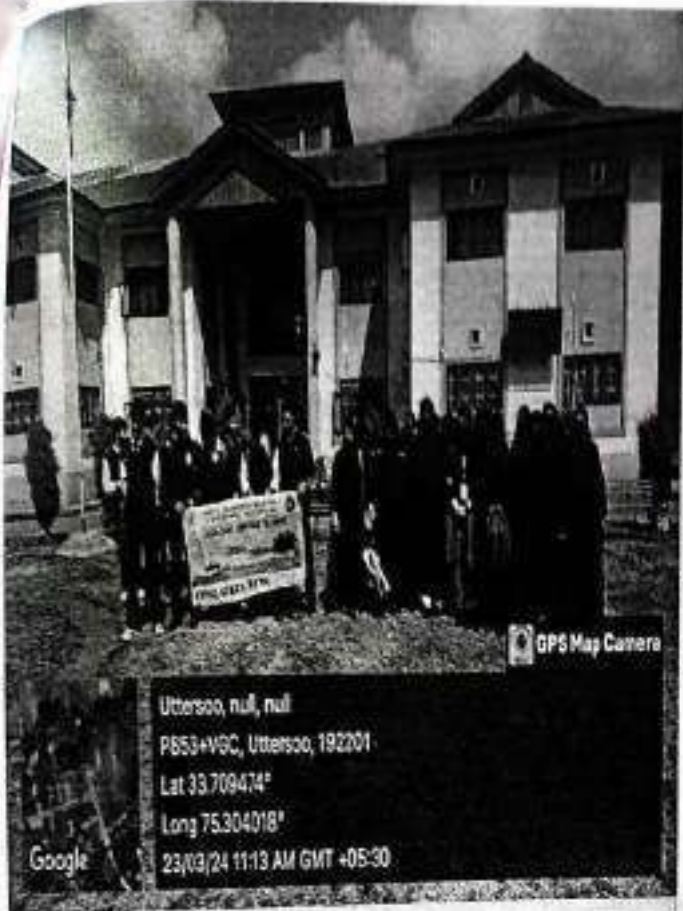

## Report of Orientation Programme for NSS Volunteers regarding their duties on Polling day.

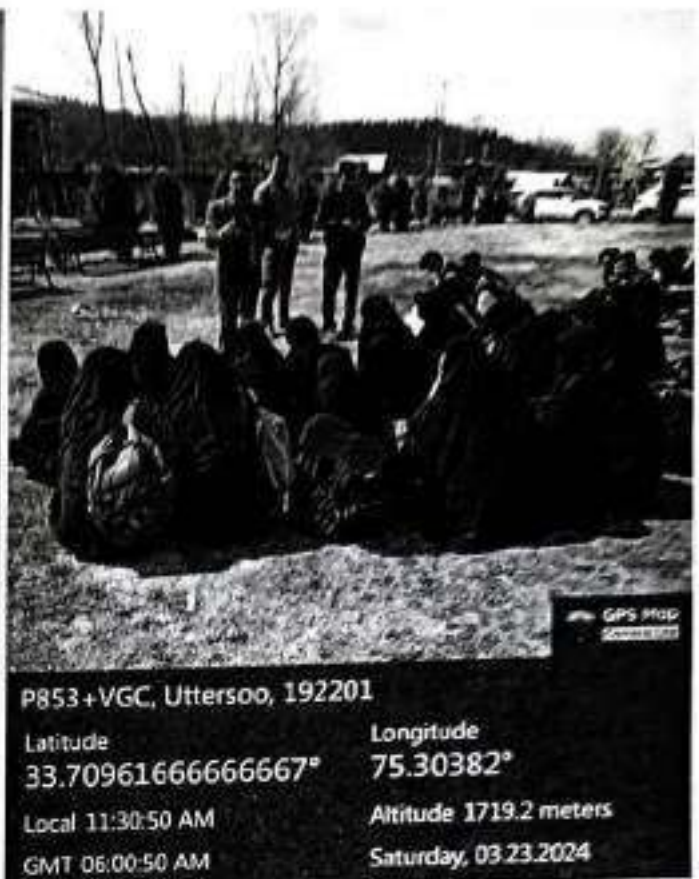

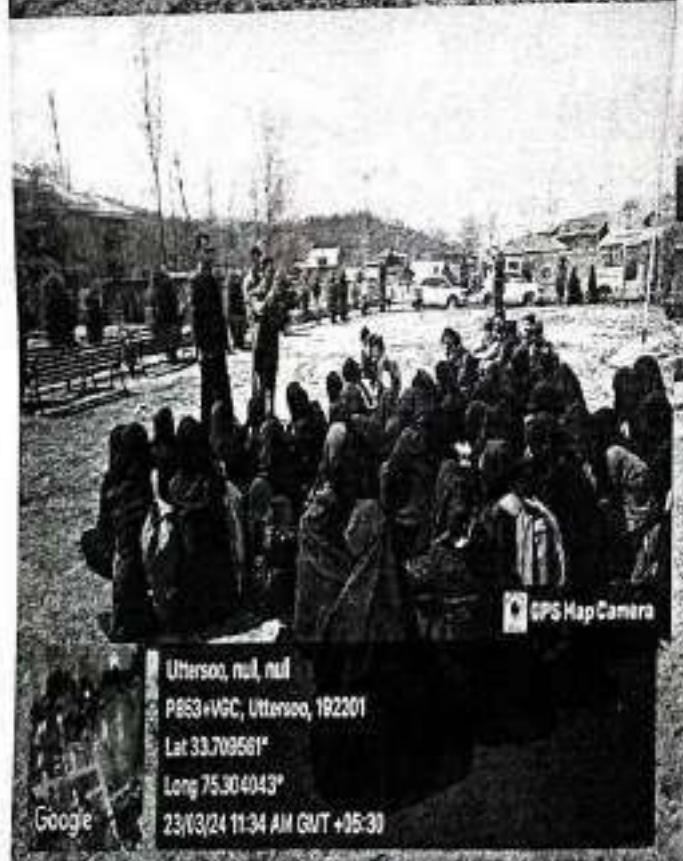

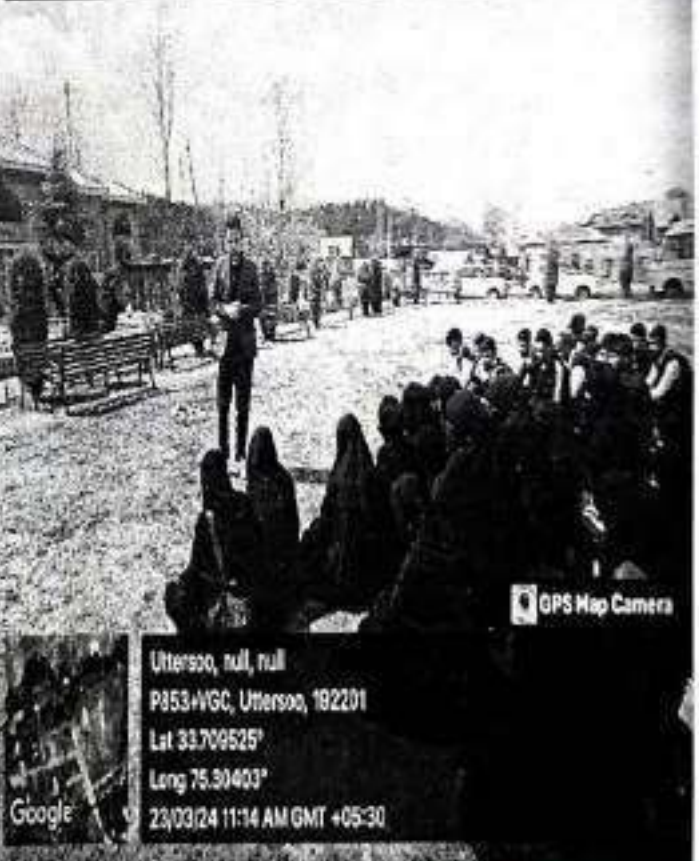

## GDC Uttersoo organized "Plantation Drive"

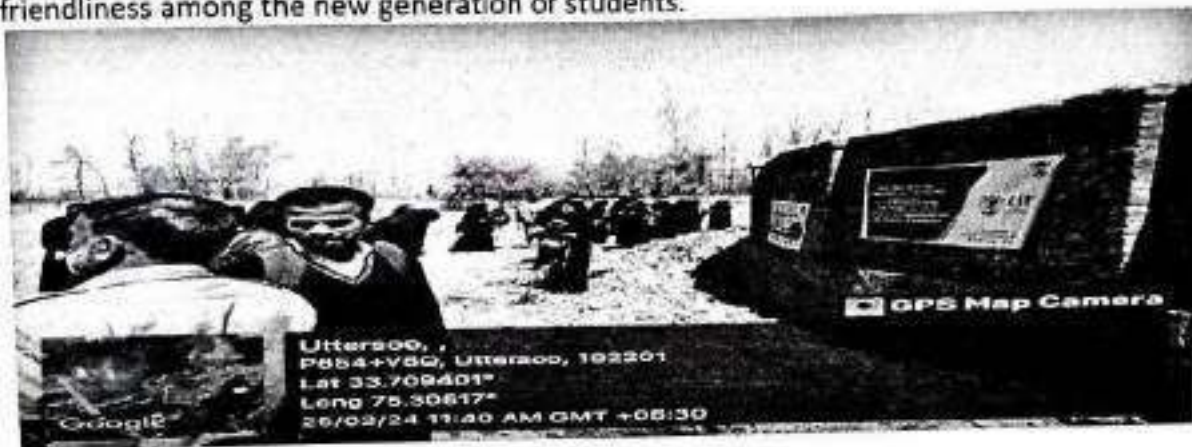

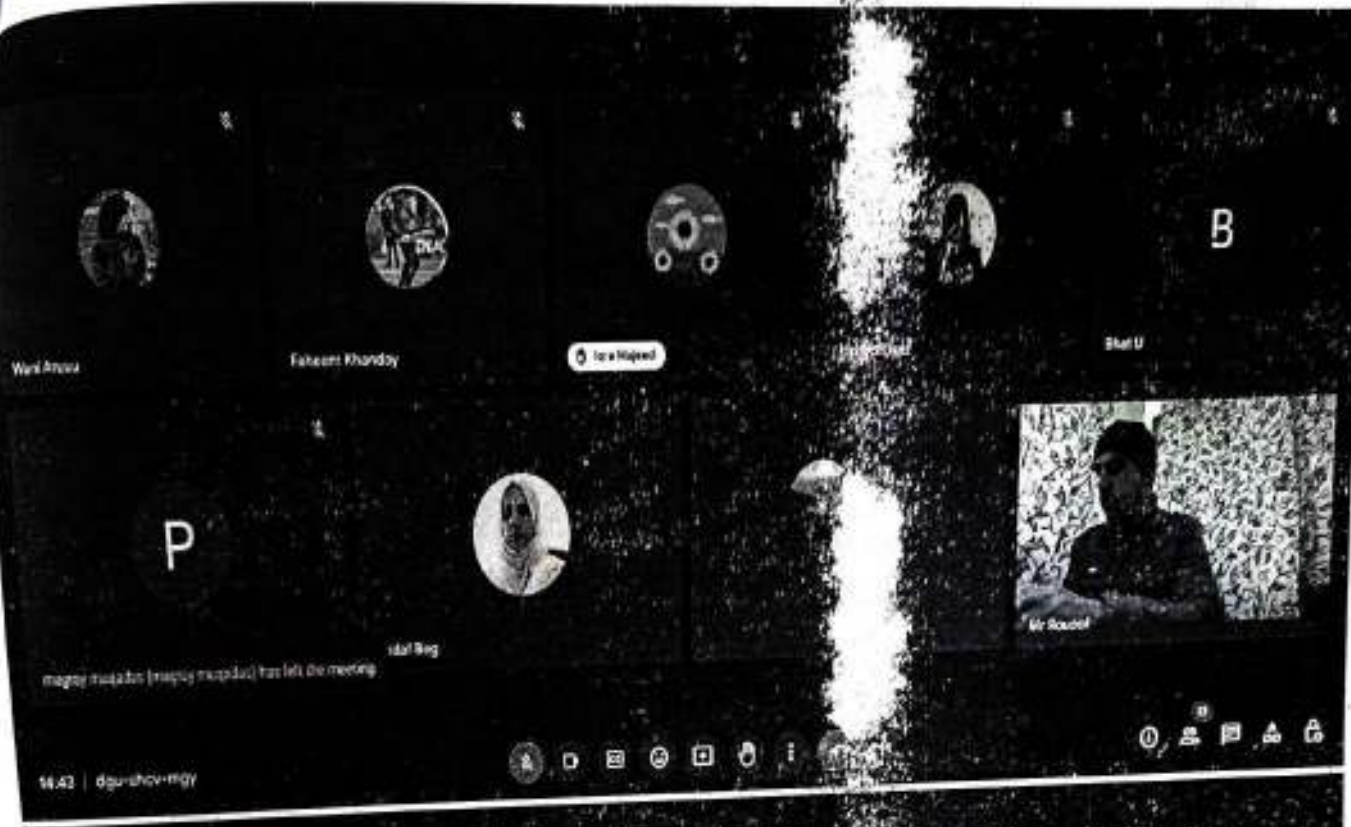


## Report of National Girl Child Day on 24<sup>th</sup> January 2024

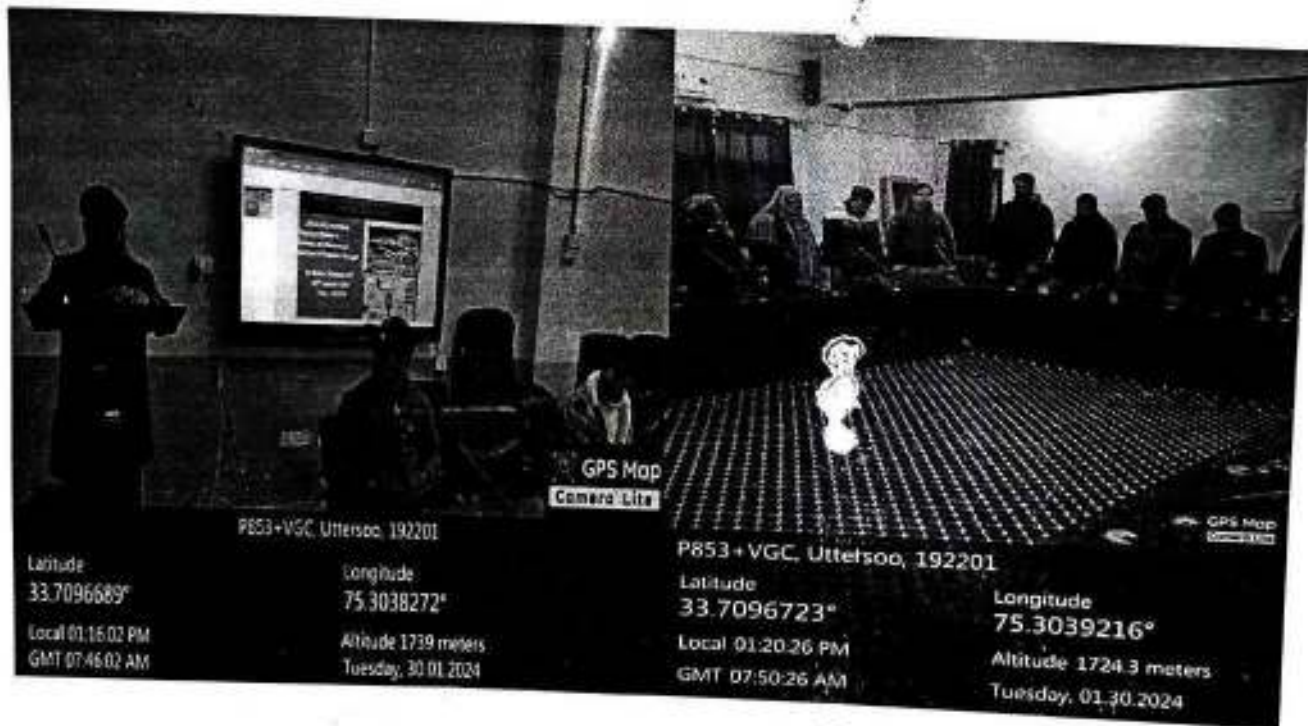

### Report of Participation in Awareness Program on "Criminal Laws" at Town Hall Achabal

On 15th March 2024, program on "Amended Criminal Laws" was organized by District Police Anantnag under the leadership of SDPO Achabal Anantnag. The Program was conducted in Town Hall Anantnag. Thirty students from GDC Uttersoo accompanied by Prof Rouoof Habib, NSS PO, Prof Basharat Hussain, HOD Economics and Mr Aqif Ahmad participated in the program from 2PM to 4:00 PM.

The program started with the inaugural address by SDPO Achabal Dysp Ab Raqeeb Malik, in which he highlighted the criminal laws and the need for the amendment and the important clauses of the laws. Then Assistant Public Prosecutor Shangus, Mr Wasiq Amin gave a detailed lecture on new amended criminal laws. The speaker highlighted that Indian Penal Code 1860, Code of Criminal Procedure 1898 and Indian Evidence Act 1872 have been replaced by Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita 2023, Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 and Bhartiya Sakshya Adhiniyam 2023 respectively.



He stressed that new laws have been framed keeping in view three basic principles—civil liberty of citizens, human rights and equality. The speaker informed that audience that new criminal laws were framed



due to colonial legacy, pendency and delay, low conviction rates, overcrowded prisons and undertrials, modernization and liberalization of criminal justice. The speaker also informed that new terms like organized crime, mob lynching, unauthorized publishing of court proceedings, petty organized crimes, community service as punishment etc were introduced in these new criminal laws. 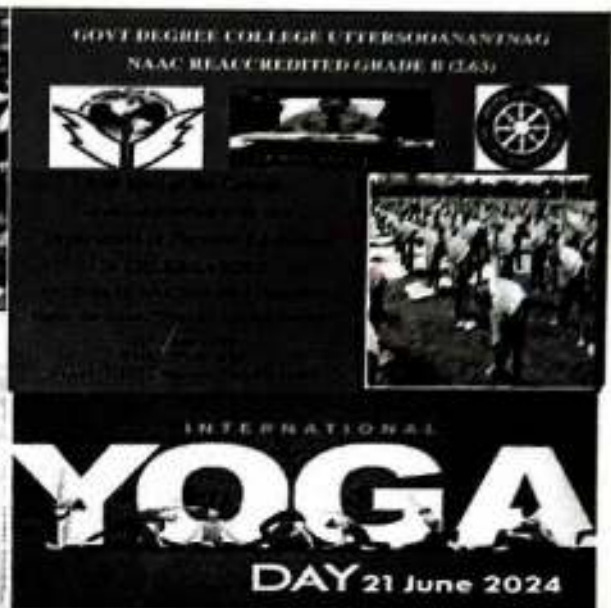
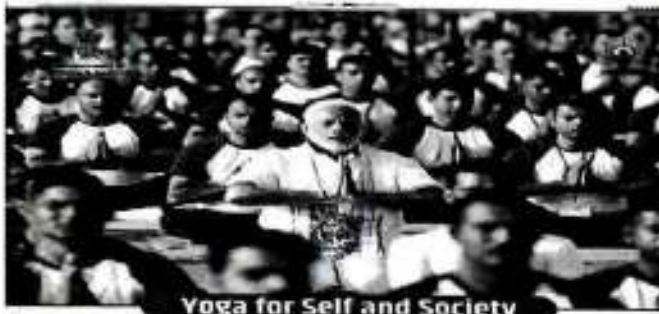

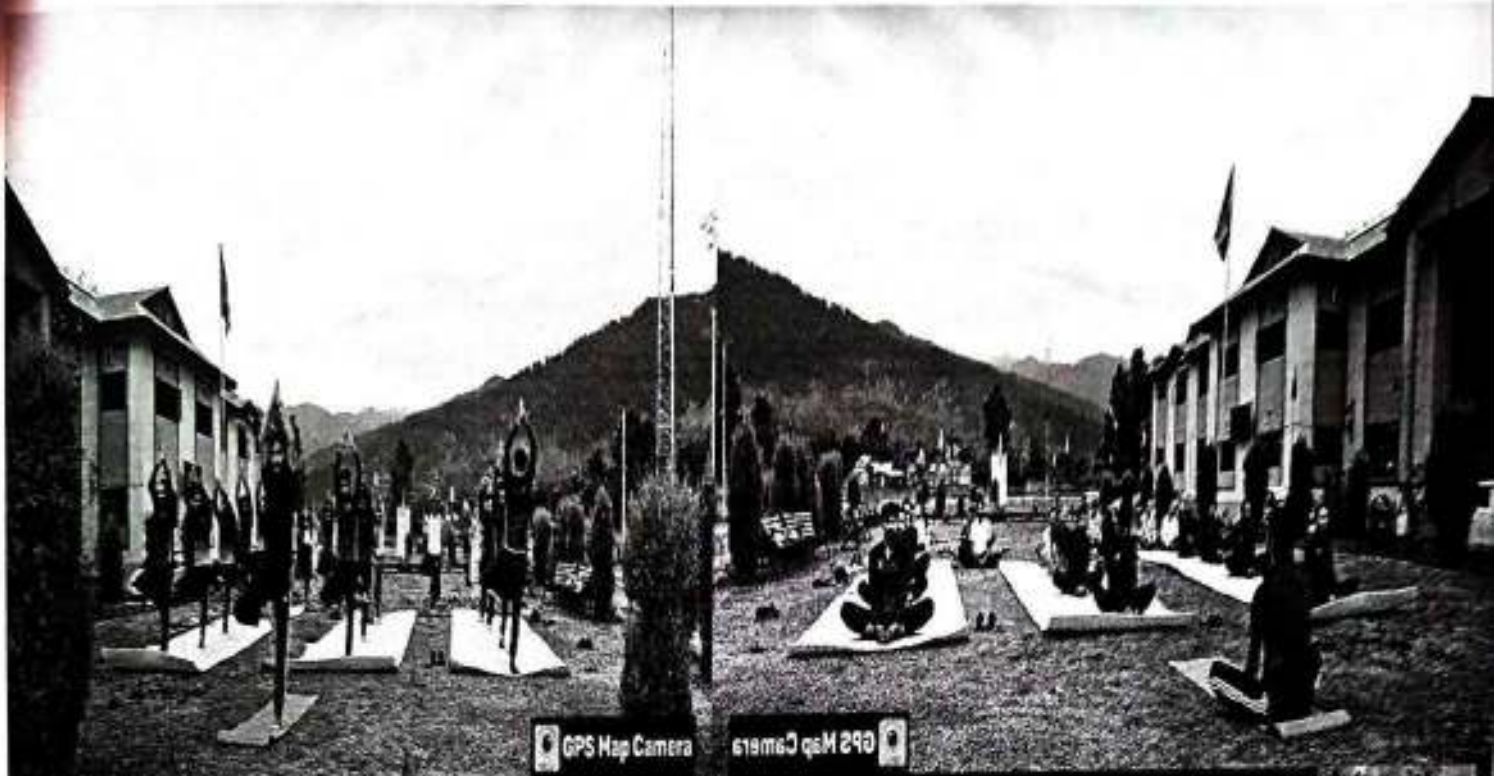


## Report of International Yoga Day on 21<sup>st</sup> June 2024

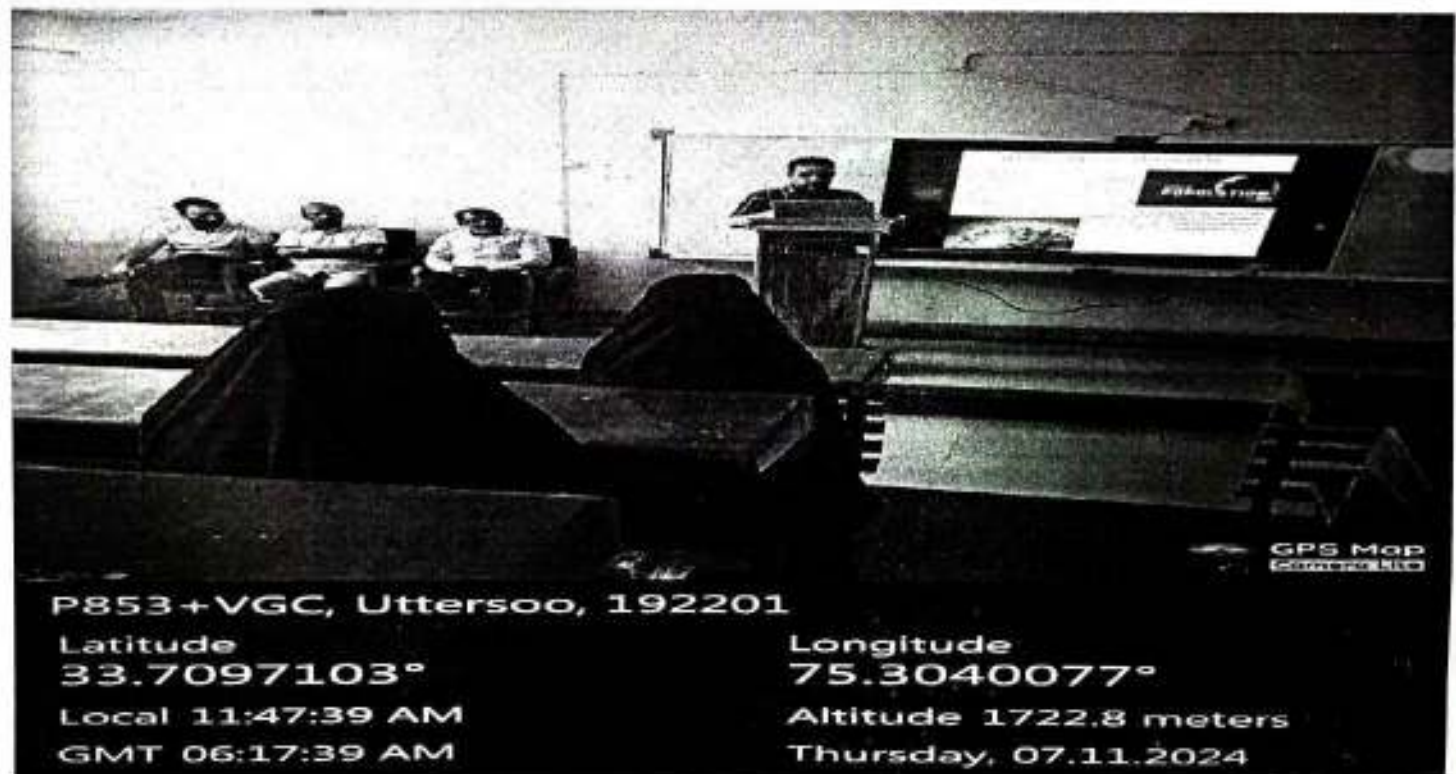
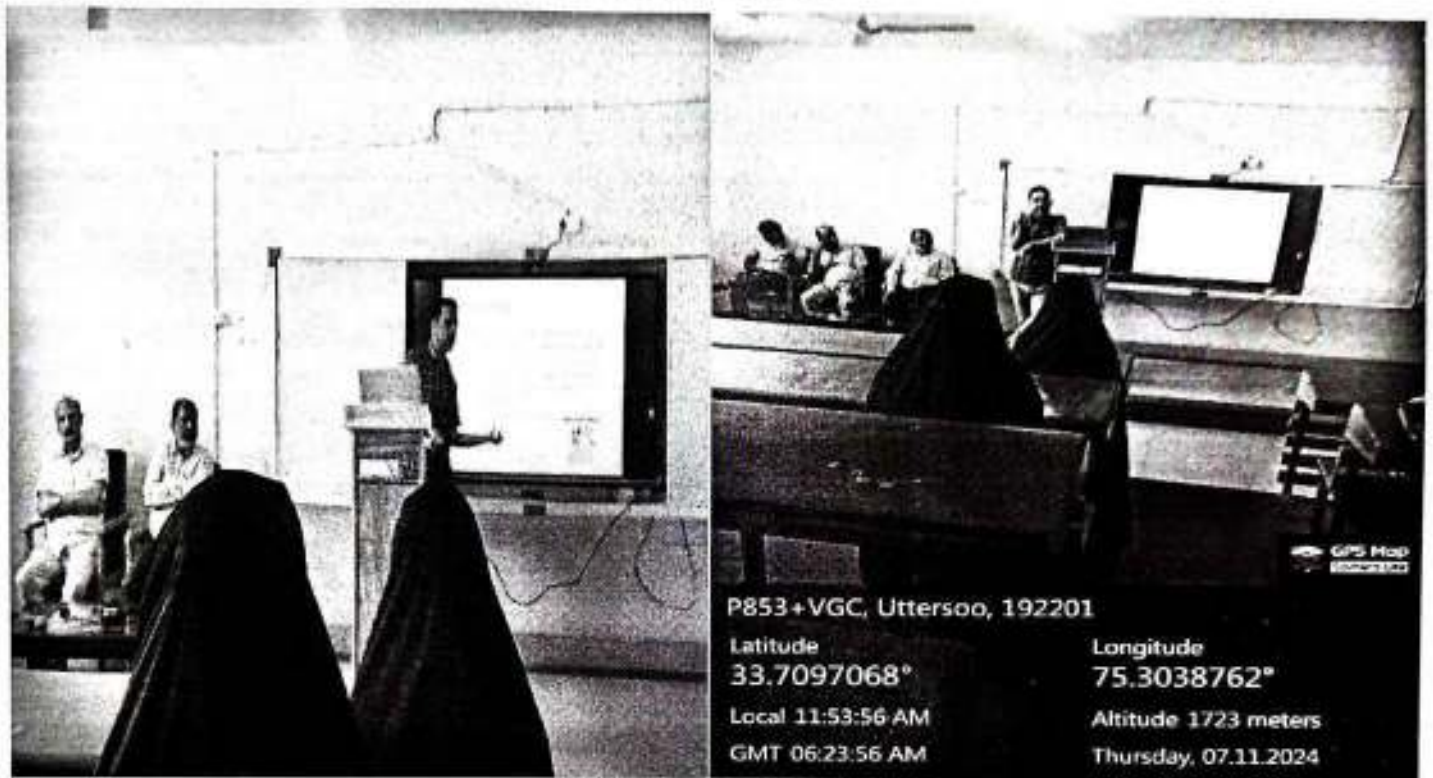


## Report of World Population Day celebration on 11<sup>th</sup> July 2024

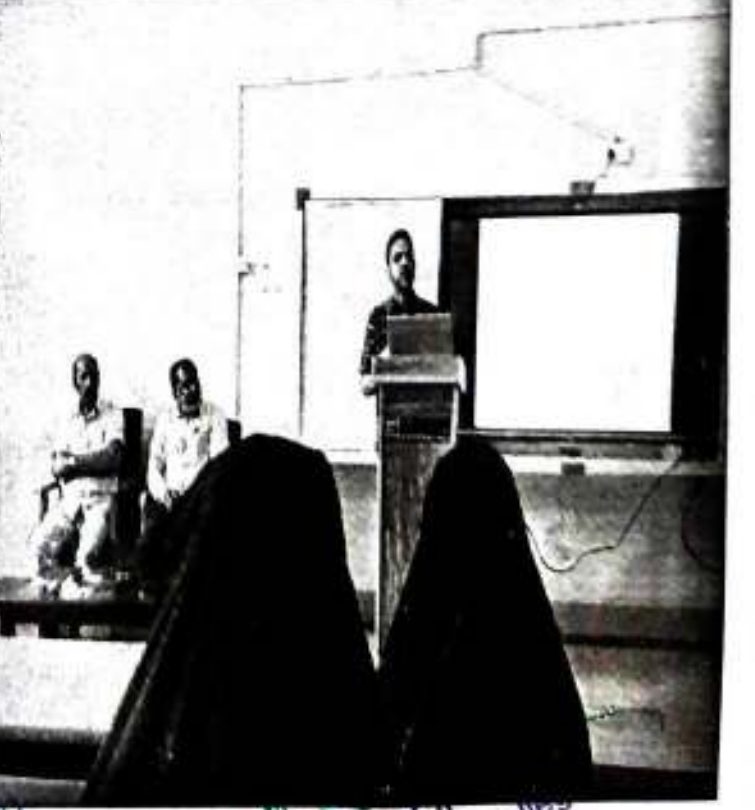
