

Feedback of Alumni - 2020

Feedback form was given by the IQAC and academic monitoring committee of the college to get the feedback from the alumni of the college. Some questions were posed in the feedback form and the Students were asked to express their views openly about the aspects they thought need any improvement.

Following questions were posed to the students and students were asked to express their views openly to express their experiences in the college and locate the areas of improvement in the teaching learning transaction:

- 1) Do you think the college met your expectations?
- 2) 10. Do you think that the college has improved its standards since you graduated?
- 3) 11. What are your suggestions to improve the Teaching-learning transactions at the college?
- 4) 12. Are you ready for an Alumni Meet at the college?

The feedback of the students laid emphasis on involving the students in teaching learning processes which according to them could be achieved through conducting the lecture that encourage students to ask questions. Students also pointed out those learning experiences of the students should be personalised. Moreover, it was suggested that modern and effective means of teaching and learning transactions should be adopted. Lastly students also highlighted that some portion of the lecture/class should be dedicated to the discussion.

The feedback is described briefly below:


1. Students should be given more chances to express themselves through debates and seminars and other programs
2. The classes should be kept interactive

- 4. Frequent discussions should be organised
- 5. Teacher-student bond must be improved
- 6. Co-curricular activities must be focussed upon
- 7. Library updation with more number of books and software

Recommendations:

- 1. More debates, seminars, cultural activities and co-curricular activities must be organised
- 2. Mentor-mentee programs must be initiated
- 3. Classrooms must be made smart with more technical infrastructure
- 4. Teachers must be asked to keep their classes interactive – Academic Monitoring Committee
