A Report:

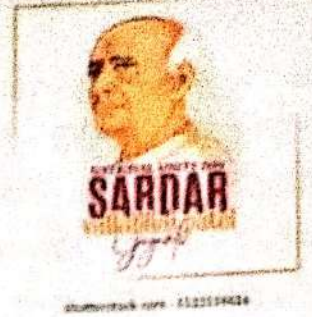

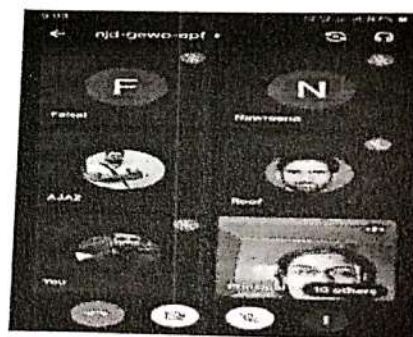

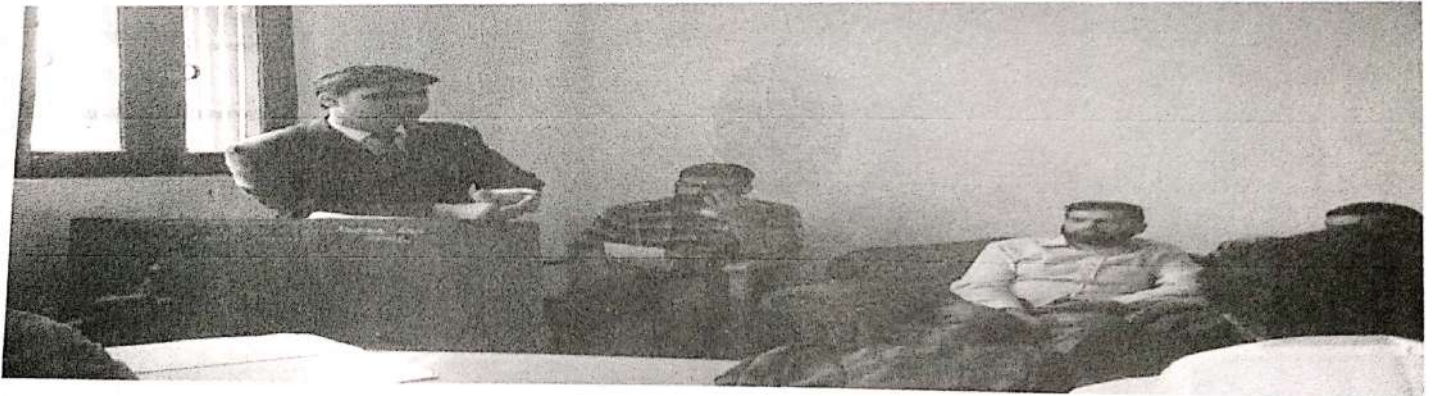

Report of One Day Webinar on Panchayati Raj on 24th December 2021 under AKAM

Department of Political Science in collaboration with Debates and Seminars committee of the College organised One Day webinar on the topic **Working of Panchayati Raj in India** with Prof. Zain Hussain Bhatt, Assistant Professor Political Science, GDC Doda on 24th December 2021. The programme commenced with brief introduction about the topic given by Javaid Ahmad Kumar, Assistant Professor Political Science. The welcome address to the guest was presented by Mr. Mohammad Arif Khanday, Assistant Professor Botany followed by the lucid presentation by the resource person. He highlighted the historical development of the concept of democratic decentralisation in India. He cited the recommendations of some of the important committees framed by different national governments in post-independent India. He brought into limelight the concept of democratic decentralisation materialised in 1994 through constitutional amendments producing an era of democratic upsurge. He also presented the evidences from Jammu and Kashmir which witnessed Panchayat elections in recent years. At last an interactive session was witnessed as participants including some faculty members posed questions to the resource person. The vote of thanks was presented by Mr. Tariq Bashir, Assistant Professor History. The whole programme was moderated by Javaid Ahmad Kumar, Assistant Professor Political Science who also happens to be the Convener of Seminar and Debates committee.
