Feedback analysis Session 2021 (offline formed).

A survey study was conducted by the IQAC of the college to get the feedback from the students currently studying in the college regarding different aspects —curricular, co-curricular, administrative, etc. Random sampling method was adopted for the study. A sample of 43 students was selected from all the semesters across all the streams. Attitudinal scale consisting of 10 components was administered on the total sample of 43 students. In order to analyse the data, percentage method was adopted. The main findings of the survey are as under(also highlighted in the table which are as under:

Main Findings:

- 1. The survey reveals that the attitude of the students towards the teachers regarding the above mentioned 09 components isquite satisfactorily.
- 2. However, in component 04 (namely Tech- savvy), 81%students opined that the teachers aren't either well adept at using the latest technology or they just ignore it.
- 3. An open space for suggestions was there for the students to express their views freely about any aspect/s they thought needs any improvement. In majority of the cases, the students appreciated the college administration and the facilities within the campus. However, some students have pointed towards the fact that the college

ignores the co-curricular activities – there's no gymnasium, sports ground or any other facility for recreation.

Recommendations:

In the above context, the IQAC makes the following recommendations for the perusal of the Principal:

- 1. Steps must be taken towards the development of sports infrastructure in the college sports ground, gymnasium, etc.
- 2. The committees which look after co-curricular activities Debates and seminars committee, cultural committee, etc must be stimulated to organise the events more often.
- 3. The teachers must be asked to get trained to get well acquainted with the latest technology ICT so that they can deliver better in the classrooms. In addition, the administration of the college must push the higher education department for the provision of funds for the procurement of smart-boards.
