Subject: Arrangement of Amanuensis/Scribe to differently abled students;


University Order No; (Conduct-Differently Abled)CE/UK of 2021; Dated:24-11-2021

The Vice Chancellor has been pleased to authorize the Principals of Degree Colleges affiliated with the University of Kashmir to arrange the Amanuensis/Scribe for the students having benchmark disability with physical limitations to read/write duly authenticated by the prescribed medical authority subject to the fulfillment of following conditions:

1. The Amanuensis/ Scribe should be a student of lower grade of education at least one step than that of the examinee and should be of different stream from the examinee.

Explanation (If a candidate is appearing in BA 1st Year examination the Amanuensis/Scribe must be a student of 12th standard or lower class or so on.

2. Concerned College Principal shall forward the details of the students and Amanuensis/Scribes to the office of the Controller of Examinations after the conclusion of the Examinations.




Subject: Proposal for establishing information and enquiry cell for persons with special needs.



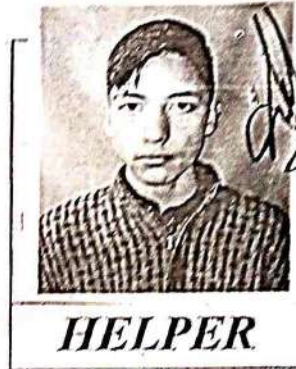

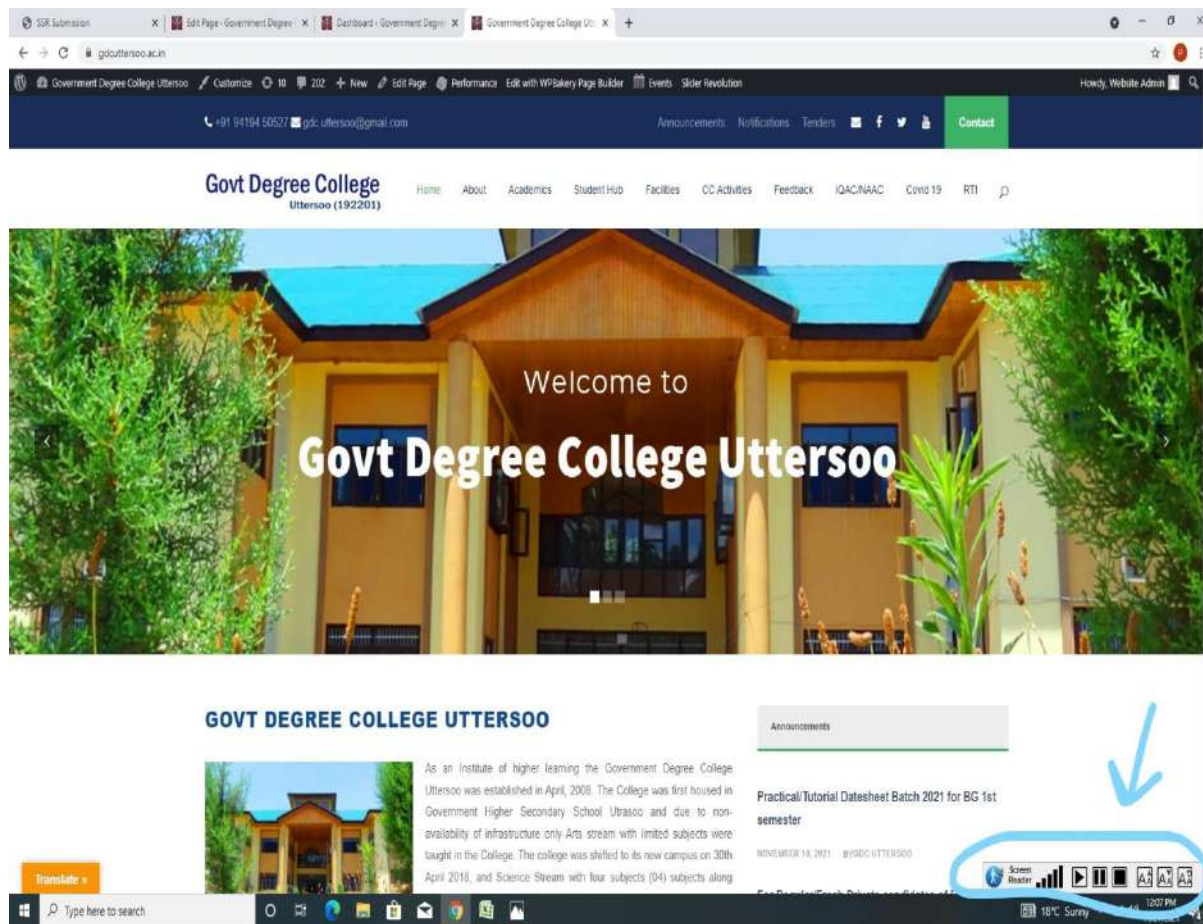


Figure 1 Website accessible with Screen-reader
